SUBJECT: Reporting Work Zone Photo Monitoring violations (WZPM)

The Laws of 2021, Chapter 421, as amended by the Laws of 2025, Chapter 58, Part Q (see also, Vehicle and Traffic Law [VTL] § 1180-e), authorize the Department of Transportation (DOT), Thruway Authority and New York State (NYS) Bridge Authority to establish demonstration programs for photo monitoring of maximum posted speed limits in work zones (hereinafter referred to as "work zone photo monitoring" or "WZPM") to assist in enforcement of violations of VTL § 1180 (b), (d), (f) and (g) occurring in a work zone. In addition, pursuant to VTL § 1803 (11), (12) and (15), any monetary penalties received as a result of an adjudication of a WZPM liability generally must be distributed eighty percent (80%) to DOT, Thruway Authority or NYS Bridge Authority (depending on the agency whose program is underlying the liability), and twenty percent (20%) to the city, town or village in which the violation giving rise to the liability occurred or, where a DOT or Thruway Authority WZPM liability is disposed of by a county-established traffic and parking violations agency, to the county in which the violation giving rise to the liability occurred.

When reporting liabilities of VTL §1180- e **originating from a work zone photo monitoring program** to the Justice Court Fund, including dismissals, cases where a monetary penalty is collected by the court, and cases where no monetary penalty is or will be collected by the court, the information set forth in the chart below must be included:

- If the liability occurred in your municipality and originated from the DOT WZPM Program, you should enter "DOT" as the offense description notation; no additional information is required.
- If the liability **occurred in another municipality** and originated from the **DOT WZPM Program**, you should enter "DOTR" as the offense description notation and include the name of the municipality where the violation giving rise to the liability occurred.
- If the liability occurred in your municipality and originated from the Thruway Authority WZPM Program, you should enter "WZPM" as the offense description notation; no additional information is required.
- If the liability occurred in another municipality and originated from the Thruway Authority WZPM Program, you should enter "WZPMR" as the offense description notation and include the name of the municipality where the violation giving rise to the liability occurred.

- If the liability occurred in your municipality and originated from the NYS Bridge Authority WZPM Program, you should enter "NYSB" as the offense description notation; no additional information is required.
- If the liability occurred in another municipality and originated from the NYS Bridge Authority WZPM Program, you should enter "NYSBR" as the offense description notation and include the name of the municipality where the violation giving rise to the liability occurred.
- When reporting violations of VTL § 1180 (b), (d), (f) or (g) not related to a WZPM Program, no offense description notation is required.
