SUBJECT: Reporting liabilities under the Westchester County Photo Monitoring Program

(Vehicle and Traffic Law § 1111-g)

The Laws of 2023, chapter 501 amends the Vehicle and Traffic Law (VTL) to add a new section (VTL § 1111-g) to allow Westchester County to establish a demonstration program to install and operate traffic-control signal photo violation-monitoring devices ("red-light cameras") within the County. These red-light cameras will assist in enforcing violations of VTL § 1111 (d) (failure to comply with red traffic-control signals). In addition, pursuant to VTL § 1803 (13), any monetary penalties received by town and village courts resulting from the adjudication of notice of liabilities under this demonstration program must be distributed eighty percent (80%) to Westchester County and twenty percent (20%) to the town or village in which the violation giving rise to the liability occurred.

To ensure the proper distribution of monetary penalties, when reporting liabilities of VTL § 1111g **originating from Westchester County red-light cameras** to the Justice Court Fund, the information set forth in the chart below must be included.

- If the liability **occurred in your municipality**, you should enter "RLPM" as the offense description notation and no additional information is required.
- If the liability **occurred in another municipality**, you should enter "RLPMR" as the offense description notation *and* include the name of the municipality where the violation giving rise to the liability occurred.
- When you are reporting violations of VTL § 1111 (d) not related to the Westchester County red-light camera program, no additional offense description notation is required.
