RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS

The official responses to questions submitted pursuant to the above-captioned procurement are listed below. Responses are in **bold blue type**.

Question #1: Minimum Qualification #2 states that proposers must have “permission from The Wiseman Group to deliver Multipliers and Impact Players training throughout the term of the agreement.” Can this requirement be satisfied through a subcontractor or teaming partner who holds such authorization, provided that partner is identified in the proposal and committed to delivering the training?

Response: Yes, provided that the subcontractor is authorized by The Wiseman Group to deliver the Multipliers and Impact Players training. Please know that the vendor selected for contract award must provide a copy of its written permission from The Wiseman Group to deliver the Multipliers and Impact Players training before service may begin.

Question #2: Minimum Qualification #2 states that proposers must have “permission from The Wiseman Group to deliver Multipliers and Impact Players training throughout the term of the agreement.” The Wiseman Group has established licensed delivery partners. Would a proposer whose subcontractor is one of these authorized partner organizations meet Minimum Qualification #2?

Response: See response to Question #1.

Question #3: Minimum Qualification #2 states that proposers must have “permission from The Wiseman Group to deliver Multipliers and Impact Players training throughout the term of the agreement.” Given the proprietary nature of the Multipliers and Impact Players programs, can OSC clarify whether this requirement is intended to allow participation from all authorized delivery partners and facilitators within The Wiseman Group ecosystem, including those engaged through subcontracting arrangements?
