Dear Chairman Lhota:

As required by Section 170 of the Executive Law, detailed below are the updated actions that have been taken to address the recommendation contained in the above-referenced audit report. The report contained one recommendation. Our response, dated October 6, 2017, indicated that the LIRR had consistently used the Arch Street Yard and Shop Facility ("Facility") and had a plan to occupy and utilize the Facility from the present until the completion of the East Side Access Project ("ESA Opening Day").

Recommendation No. 1

Perform a written cost-benefit analysis to determine what the best use is for the Facility and the equipment until ESA is open.

LIRR Implementation Status: Implemented

As indicated in our October 6, 2017 response, the LIRR continues to mobilize for its intended occupation of the Facility from the date Metro-North Railroad Positive Train Control is completed in November 2018 until ESA Opening Day. While the scope of the intended use of the Facility has not changed, the projected usage dates have been updated based on further analysis of outstanding projects, the needs of LIRR and the best use of the Facility. As critical milestone projects were achieved, the LIRR was able to more accurately reflect usage dates. The LIRR has determined that the most efficient use of the Facility is to utilize it for the following:

- M9 car modification work is expected to take place between September 2018 and
- Commissioning of ESA Rescue Locomotive and the LIRR/New York Atlantic Rail work locomotives is expected to take place between December 2020 and February 2022.
- M9A car testing and commissioning is expected to take place between April 2022 and July 2024.
- Wheel Truing machine located in the Facility is expected to be used as part of an ongoing annual process for potential back log of out-of-service equipment, if any.
- Equipment on legal hold pending investigative review is expected to be stored at the Facility.

The above noted items are part of the LIRR's formal and approved plan which we believe addresses the recommendation of the New York State Comptroller's Office. Please contact me should you require additional information.
