Dear Comptroller DiNapoli:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 170 of the Executive Law, the following are actions that the State Education Department (SED) has taken, or will be taking, to implement the recommendations contained in the Office of the State Comptroller's (OSC) Final Audit Report (2018-S-28) Compliance with the Reimbursable Cost Manual: Association to Benefit Children (ABC).

## Recommendation 1:

"Review the recommended disallowances resulting from our audit and, if warranted, make the appropriate adjustments to the costs reported on ABC's CFR and to ABC's tuition reimbursement rates."

SED is currently in the process of reviewing the Consolidated Fiscal Report (CFR) and OSC audit work papers and will make necessary adjustments and recover any overpayments, as appropriate, by recalculating tuition rates.

## Recommendation 2:

"Work with ABC officials to help ensure their compliance with the provisions in the Manual and Claiming Manual."

SED will continue to provide technical assistance whenever requested and will strongly recommend the ABC officials avail themselves of our assistance to help them better understand the rules for cost reporting and criteria for cost reimbursement as presented in the CFR, Regulation and the Reimbursable Cost Manual (RCM). Furthermore, SED will alert ABC of online training that is available on SED's webpage. SED recommends that all individuals signing the CFR certification statements, namely the Executive Director and Certified Public Accountant, complete this training. This training is a requirement for preschool special education providers upon approval and reapproval.

Furthermore, SED will require ABC to identify the actions it has taken to cure and correct the deficiencies and/or violations identified in the audit. ABC's submission to SED must be certified by its Chief Executive Officer, with an attestation from each director, officer, trustee, and shareholder, and must contain all relevant information describing how policies, procedures and practices have been revised to address the specific findings of the audit, and how systemic changes to the internal controls and financial oversight have been implemented.
