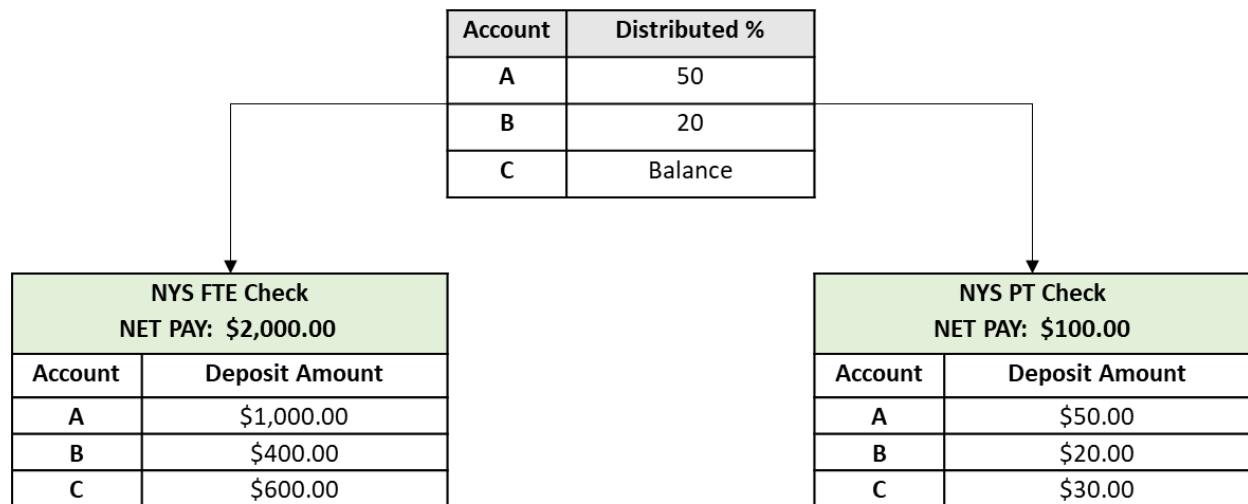


Direct Deposit Distribution Examples for PayServ v. 9.2:

In PayServ v. 9.2, employees will have a single direct deposit record that is applied to all payroll payments. If an employee has multiple accounts that receive money, every check will be disbursed according to the employee's single record. Examples of how this distribution will work are below.

Percent Distribution with Multiple Checks

This example is for an employee who is a full time NYS employee (NYS FTE) and a part time Civil Service Proctor (NYS PT) with three bank accounts (A, B, and C) set to the following percent distribution (all checks will be deposited according to this single record):



Amount Distribution with Multiple Checks

This example is for an employee who is a full time NYS employee (NYS FTE) and a part time Court Proctor (NYS PT) with three bank accounts (A, B, and C) set to the following amount distribution (all checks will be deposited according to this single record):
