Subject : Salary Increases for Certain State Officers and  
Judges and Justices of the Unified Court System

Chapter 55 of the Laws of 1979 provides for increases in salary, effective October 1, 1979, for State officers whose salaries are set in Section 169 of the Executive Law, for certain other officers, and for judges and justices of the Unified Court System. A list of the officers in the Executive Branch and the new salaries is attached. New salaries for the judges and justices have been distributed by the Office of Court Administration. The increase is payable from the first day of Payroll Period 14. (September 27, 1979).

The increased salaries should be reported by PR-75 in Payroll Period 14. Transaction code SAL INCR is used for this purpose.

The positions of Secretary to the Governor, Counsel to the Governor, and Director of the Budget have been removed from Section 169. However, Chapter 55 provides for an increase in salary for these positions not to exceed \$57,500.
