<p>Effective January 1, 1983 Social Security contributions will be deducted from the first \$35,700 in covered wages paid to an employee by each employer.</p> <p>The rate of contribution for employer and employee will remain at 6.7%. The maximum deduction for the 1983 calendar year will be \$2,391.90.</p> <p>The deductions will become effective in the first paycheck of the new year which is January 4, 1983 for Administration-Rotating, January 6, 1983 for Institution-Normal and January 12, 1983 for both Administration-Normal and Institution-Rotating.</p>
