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| Subject Dues and Agency Shop Fee Increase for the Public Employees Federation | Bulletin No. P-420 |

The biweekly dues and agency shop fee deductions for the Public Employees Federation have been increased effective in Period 26-LAG, Institution checks dated April 11, 1985 and Administration checks dated April 17, 1985.

The new dues (code 233) and agency shop fee (code 247) structure is as follows:

Annual full-time employees

Pay Basis Codes ANN, CAL, 8AN

Pay Basis Code 10M (based on 22 payroll periods)

| 30,001 to 50,000 | 8.90 |

Part-time employees, including all employees with pay basis codes HRY, DLY, FEE or BIW and all annual-salaried employees with a part-time percentage, will pay 0.75% of the biweekly gross, not to exceed \$7.25 biweekly.

The dues and agency shop fee changes will be processed automatically by the Office of the State Comptroller for Period 26. The amounts will also be recalculated automatically whenever required. Please notify your employees of this increase and the effective date of the new deduction.
