New Payroll Deduction for PEF

A new payroll deduction has been established for employees who are members of PEF to allow for voluntary contributions for the support of candidates for federal office. The name of this fund is PEF-COPE. Code 214 has been established for this fund. Employees must have dues (code 233) to be eligible for this deduction.

The original deduction transactions will be submitted directly to the Office of the State Comptroller by PEF. The payroll agency is responsible for initiating this deduction only for the following situations:

- 1. transfer from one agency to another
- 2. reinstatement from a leave of absence without pay
- 3. upon restoral to the payroll after any other type of removal.

If deduction code 214 must be submitted on an AC-1040, submit code 214 in a "Code" Block and the amount to be deducted in the "Amount" Block. An AC-1040 prepared for Code 214 must also contain PEF dues deduction.

In accordance with the State Finance Law (Section 201, paragraph 5), to cancel this deduction, the employee must submit a letter to the Office of the State Comptroller or to PEF requesting this cancellation. The letter should be sent to:

The deductions for code 214 will begin in Institution Payroll Period 21 Lag checks dated April 23, 1987 and Administration Period 1 Lag checks dated April 29, 1987.
