Reporting Union Dues and Insurances for Transfers and Reinstated Employees Bulletin No.

This is a reminder that it is the payroll agency's responsibility to report union dues and insurances (other than State health) on an AC-1040 under the following circumstances:

- On transfer or reassignment of an employee from one agency to another. Contact the previous agency and report all dues and insurances in effect in that agency.
- 2. On reinstatement of an employee from leave without pay or after any type of removal. Dues should always be restarted. Refer to the Payroll Manual Chapter D, Section 4 page 16 for the correct procedure on insurances.

This procedure applies for dues and insurances for all unions.

It is essential that the payroll office submit an AC-1040 with the correct dues and insurance codes so that an employee's union membership and insurance coverage continue.
