The biweekly dues and agency shop fee deduction for the Civil Service Employees Association will be changed effective in Payroll Period 19L, checks dated January 7, 1998 for Administration and Payroll Period 20L, checks dated January 15, 1998 for Institution agencies.

The new dues (Code 201) and agency shop fee (Code 212) structure is as follows:

Dues for 10-month employees will be based on the above salary structure.

Dues for annual part-time employees will be calculated based on their part-time percentage.

OSC will automatically recalculate the dues and agency shop fee amounts for the January payrolls. Once established, the biweekly amounts are not increased for individual employees during 1998, even if an employee's salary is increased. Amounts are changed only to reflect the percentage of time worked during the year if the employee changes to part-time, goes on sick leave with half-pay, or changes to full-time. This is the responsibility of each agency.
