Subject Cancellation of Retirement Information for Retirees Returning to Employment with New York State Under Section 211 or 212 of the Retirement and Social Security Law	Bulletin No. P-982
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This bulletin supplements Payroll Bulletin P-975 dated January 23, 1998 (Employment Restrictions Pertaining to Retirees of Public Retirement Systems in New York State).

If you rehire or appoint under Section 211 or 212 of the Retirement and Social Security Law a retired employee who previously worked for a New York State agency, you should cancel the retirement information before the first paycheck. You may use the on-line deduction processing screen, selection number 3, to determine previous retirement membership and to cancel the information.

If an employee has suspended retirement benefits under Section 101 of the NYS Retirement and Social Security Law, do not cancel retirement information. The employee is entitled to continue membership in the retirement system as long as he or she is not collecting a retirement allowance.
