

CALCULATING A SUPPLEMENT

Using the attached Employee History Summary and Additional Pay Summary you will be calculating a workers' compensation supplemental payment for the three examples below:

EXAMPLE 1: 8/16/16-8/29/16 10 days – SIF rate is 326.16 weekly (5 days)

1. Calculate the total biweekly salary for the period 8/16/16-8/29/16 (10 days).
2. Multiply the total biweekly salary by .60 (60%).
3. Using the 60% of the salary you just calculated, subtract the amount that SIF paid for a two week period. Pay close attention to the SIF rate. **Hint** – SIF pays weekly.
4. Using the Workers Compensation Data page, fill in all the blank boxes.

EXAMPLE 2: Calculate biweekly salary, SIF amount, Supplemental amount for 5 days.

EXAMPLE 3: Calculate biweekly salary, SIF amount, Supplemental amount for 3 days.

HINT - YOU CAN MULTIPLE ALL FIGURES ALREADY CALCULATED BY THE NUMBER OF DAYS.
